



Transportation

If you are able to bring your child to camp opening day, we strongly encourage all parents to visit our facilities and meet the

camp director and your child's counselor. Otherwise, bus transportation is available for Camp Marston and Raintree Ranch from the Mission Valley YMCA for \$35. YMCA Camp Surf will pick you

up at the airport or train station for \$50.

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
